NOTES TO ANNUAL EXPENDITURE LIMITATION REPORT
YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2018

NOTE 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented as prescribed by the *Uniform Expenditure Reporting System* (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes §41-1279.07, and in accordance with the voter-approved alternative expenditure limitation adopted July 19, 2016, as authorized by the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §20 (9).

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the AELR is presented below for any

exclusion claimed in part II and each subtraction or addition in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds and the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Position for the Proprietary Funds, and the Statement of Cash Flows for the Proprietary Funds.

NOTE 2. RECONCILIATION SUBTRACTIONS AND ADDITIONS:

The deduction for depreciation and the addition for principal payments on long term debt are all provided in the Statement of Cash Flows for the proprietary funds and the financial statement footnotes 7 and 8.

The subtraction of \$12,712 for pension

expense consists of the change in the net pension liability recognized in the current year in the proprietary fund. The addition of \$21,457 for pension contributions paid in the current year consists of the required pension contributions made to the Arizona State Retirement System from the proprietary fund.

NOTE 3. EXCLUSIONS:

Exclusions from local revenues, including those enumerated in the Constitution, may be taken against alternative expenditure limitations only if such exclusions are specifically identified in the resolution and the

publicity pamphlet. The government's most current resolution specifies exclusions that may be taken, however no exclusions are reported within this document.
